The Company shall, in accordance with the Listing Rules governing it, promptly issue a Public Notice once written communication is received from the Government on the future of the Umeme Concession.

The Company remains committed to performing its obligations as per the existing Concession and will continue to operate and maintain the electricity distribution system in line with prudent utility practice to ensure continued service delivery.
